

4 Men 4 Weeks For My Brothers Week 2: Peers

After you watch the video from Kevin, set up a time to meet virtually with the other men in your group. The following questions are designed to help you engage in conversation around the topic of the week.

Key Passages:

Proverbs 12:15, Proverbs 15:22, Proverbs 19:20, Proverbs 20:6

Group Questions:

- Look at Proverbs 12:15, 15:22, and 19:20. Who are the men that help provide counsel to you? What has it looked like for you, over the years, to find men who are peers in the faith to walk with?
- What are the barriers that keep you from meeting with men who are peers in the faith regularly? Talk about how you can overcome these barriers.
- What stood out to you in listening to Kevin, Fred and Greg talk about what it looks like and means for them to walk together? What did you notice that you want in your life? What step do you need to take to get there?
- Proverbs 20:6 says "Many a person proclaims his own loyalty, but who can find a
 trustworthy person?" The guys talked about becoming the right kind of guy for
 each other. They mentioned vulnerability, commitment, and trust. Which of these
 do you need to work on in your own life? How can the group help you?
- Being consistent and showing up were keys the guys brought out as helping them push through fatigue moments and allowing time to help build deeper bonds. What step do you need to take this week to push through to commitment with some other guys?



Prayer:

Spend time praying together over the steps each guy needs to take this week. Pray for each guy to find/continue developing relationships with other men who can walk together toward the Lord.

Action Steps:

These two steps will help you move forward this week in your walk with other men who are peers in the faith:

- Have a conversation with a guy you believe to be a trustworthy person and be vulnerable about your need for other men who are peers in the faith to walk with.
 See if the Lord might be opening a door through this guy.
- Spend time in prayer, the Word and write out what the Lord is showing you. If you have guys, or don't have guys yet, that you walk with, focus on becoming the right kind of guy while you seek the Lord for men to walk with.
